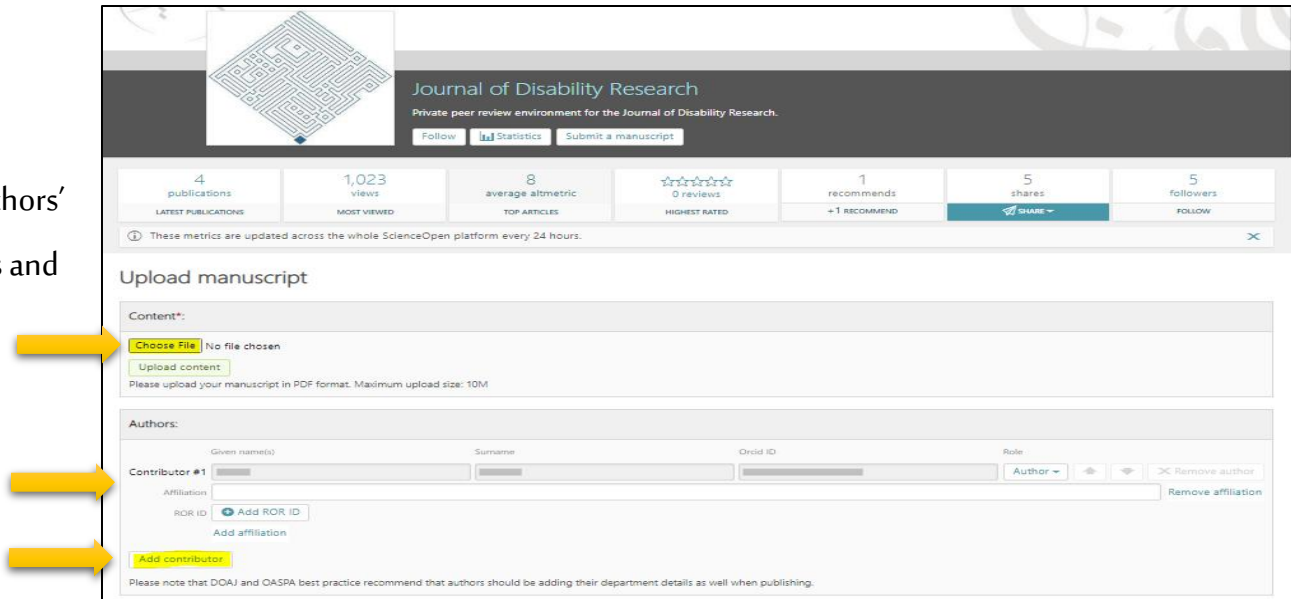


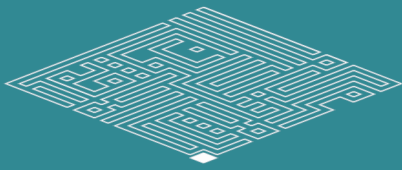
3. Sign in with your ScienceOpen account. If you do not have an account, then you should create one. Please note that it requires having an [ORCID ID](#).

4. Upload your manuscript, write the authors' information including their affiliations and [ROR ID](#).





5. Include author's email, choose the language of your paper, and add the paper's title, subtitle, and translation of the title in Arabic.

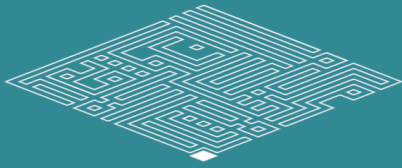
